WHAT IS RAMADAN?

People of Islam observe Ramadan to remember the month in which they believe the angel Gabriel first revealed the Quran, the holy book of Islam, to the prophet Muhammad. It is the most significant month in the Muslim calendar. During this period, People of Islam observe a daytime fast and endeavor to avoid impure thoughts and immoral actions. Being one of the five pillars of Islam, participation in this observance is obligatory for all healthy adult People of Islam.

The first ten days of the month of Ramadan are known as the Days of Mercy and Heavenly Rewards. (From February 18 to February 27) During this time, People of Islam should confess their faults, account for their actions, and seek Allah's compassion.

The following 10 days of Ramadan are known as the Days of Forgiveness. (February 27 through March 8). It is said that Allah's forgiveness is at its peak during this season. People of Islam must seek Allah's pardon for their sins and ask for the strength to avoid committing them again. Also prevalent is seeking forgiveness and reconciliation with people.

The final ten days of Ramadan are known as the Days of Salvation. (March 9 through March 18) This is the most significant ten days due to Laylat-al-Qadr (The Night of Power). During this time, People of Islam pray for deliverance from eternal damnation.

Ramadan concludes with Eid al-Fitr, known as the festival of Breaking the Fast. People of Islam celebrate and express gratitude for the strength Allah granted them during the fast. Youngsters receive gifts and new clothing, and young females may apply henna to their hands.

DAY 1
FEBRUARY 18 – WEDNESDAY

We start our 31-day prayer journey by asking God to keep calling His followers from all over the world to boldly share the gospel with the rapidly growing number of People of Islam globally. Pray that Christians won't be afraid to reach out and share God's love in humble and kind ways.

2 Corinthians 4: 4

Pray that the Holy Spirit will change hearts.

DAY 2
FEBRUARY 19 – THURSDAY

First day of Sawm (Fasting)

The time of Fasting BEGINS, Sawm, is one of the Five Pillars of Islam. All People of Islam who are physically able are expected to observe it.

Intercede on behalf of those serving around the world who are attempting to reach unreached peoples by means other than the traditional methods. Government threats and demands are making an already difficult job considerably more so. Pray. Ask God to guide and keep them safe. Pray that He will keep stirring up His Spirit to keep revealing the Truth to others.

DAY 3
FEBRUARY 20 - FRIDAY

MUMBAI, INDIA
Region: South Asia
Population: Approx. 20 million

Pray for migrants who come to Mumbai in pursuit of their dreams; ask the Lord to open their hearts to the Gospel so they will rejoice in Him who does great things.

DAY 4
FEBRUARY 21 – SATURDAY

In Mali, a kids' club meets in the house of local Christians. They teach Bible stories to over 50 Muslim children and talk about Jesus. Many parents whose kids come to the house often say their kids are getting better-behaved, working harder in school, and having more fun.

Pray that God will make it important for the parents to find out for themselves what is making their children change inside.

DAY 5
FEBRUARY 22 – SUNDAY

Hebrews 4: 12

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Pray that People of Islam will see how powerful the Bible is and accept it as the source of truth.

DAY 6
FEBRUARY 23 - MONDAY

NOUAKCHOTT, MAURITANIA
Region: Sub-Saharan Africa
Population: Approx. 1.2 million

Pray for the workers of God in Nouakchott. Pray that they will be filled with the Holy Spirit so that wisdom, knowledge and strength they need will endure all burdens and difficulty. Pray that their creativity will reap Kingdom benefits that are eternal.

DAY 7
FEBRUARY 24 – TUESDAY

The Makua-Nahara people live in the northeastern part of Mozambique. Please pray for them. Global workers operate in this area to reach out to people who are deeply rooted in both Islam and witchcraft. They do this through business as mission and community development. A number of young men and women have come out as Christians and been baptized.

Pray that more people will see Jesus and decide to follow Him no matter what.

DAY 8
FEBRUARY 25 – WEDNESDAY

Matthew 5: 17 Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

Acts 3: 22-23 For Moses said, ‘The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own people; you must listen to everything he tells you. 23Anyone who does not listen to him will be completely cut off from their people.

1 Peter 1: 10-12

Pray that People of Islam will see that all of God's prophets pointed to Jesus Christ as the way to be saved.

DAY 9
FEBRUARY 26 – THURSDAY

KHARTOUM, SUDAN
Region: Sub-Saharan Africa
Population: Approx. 5.6 million

Ask God to fill Khartoum with His Spirit and bless it with a united, Jesus-worshiping community from each of Sudan's more than 50 tribes. Pray for Sudanese Christians to follow God's lead and welcome People of Islam to worship Jesus.

Pray for peace amid racial tensions between Black and Arab Sudanese. Pray the Lord for leaders who will fight racism and discrimination with love, wisdom, and justice.

DAY 10

FEBRUARY 27 – FRIDAY

For the transformation of Upper Guinea, please pray. The region is virtually entirely Muslim, and western missionaries are leaving at an alarming rate.

Pray that international workers in the region will be supplied and sustained. Pray that additional missionaries will be called to Guinea and West Africa, and that local believers will also minister to their own people.

DAY 11

FEBRUARY 28 – SATURDAY

Ephesians 2: 8 - 9

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.

Pray that People of Islam will understand how grace, faith, and works all fit together.

DAY 12

MARCH 1 - SUNDAY

TUNIS, TUNISIA

Region: North Africa

Population: Approx. 2.3 million

Pray that the people of Tunis will find their purpose in praising God and telling everyone about Christ. Ask God to give the city more workers who can come up with creative, innovative, and professional ways to make people's lives better. Pray that the young Tunisians who are coming to the city to find work will also find the hope of the Gospel.

DAY 13

MARCH 2 – MONDAY

Pray for the people of Senegal, specifically the Wolof. We have not yet witnessed a thriving gospel movement. Thank God for the recently completed translation of the Bible. Global workers have made available theological education, for which we praise God. The nation remains approximately 94% Muslim. Pray that God might move in the Senegalese people's hearts.

DAY 14

MARCH 3 – TUESDAY

Ephesians 2: 8 - 9

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.

Pray that People of Islam will understand how grace, faith, and works all fit together.

DAY 15

MARCH 4 - WEDNESDAY

CONSTANTINE, ALGERIA

Region: North Africa Population:
Approx. 464,000

Ask God to change Constantine, which is known as a stronghold of Islam, into a city that is built on Jesus Christ. Pray that whole families will find Christ, decide to follow Him, and grow in faith and courage.

Ask God to send faithful Christians to Constantine who will build bridges so that People of Islam in the country and the whole region can hear the Gospel.

DAY 16

MARCH 5 - THURSDAY

Pray for global workers who faithfully disciple new believers from Muslim backgrounds. One of the greatest obstacles they encounter is assisting new Christians to live out the gospel in diverse cultural environments, many of which are unfriendly to Jesus-followers. Pray for encouragement, especially for those missionaries who, despite years of consistently ministering to seekers, have seen very little progress.

DAY 17

MARCH 6 - FRIDAY

1 Corinthians 15: 1-6

Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, That he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve. After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

Beseech God that People of Islam will come to terms with Jesus Christ's death and resurrection.

DAY 18

MARCH 7 - SATURDAY

TOUBA, SENEGAL

Region: Sub-Saharan Africa
Population: Approx. 530,000

Pray God to bring up Senegalese Christians who would boldly proclaim that salvation comes from the beautiful Lamb of God, not temples or tombs. Pray that Mouride followers who come to Touba seeking the truth will turn from Islam to Christ and eternal life. Ask the Lord to show the five million West Africans who think Touba is a holy city how privileged they are to trust in Jesus.

DAY 19

MARCH 8 – SUNDAY

Pray for any Muslim men who have decided to follow Jesus and who wish to share their choice with their esteemed Muslim fathers and uncles. Pray that God will give the family leaders a vision that would soften their hearts so that these new Christians might share Jesus with them. Pray for all People of Islam who choose Jesus and are subsequently confronted by their parents and family, that God would use these connections to lead more people to Him.

DAY 20

MARCH 9 – MONDAY

1 John 5: 10 - 12

Whoever believes in the Son of God accepts this testimony. Whoever does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because they have not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

Pray that People of Islam will realize and accept that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

DAY 21

MARCH 10 - TUESDAY

LAAYOUNE, MOROCCO
Region: North Africa Population:
Approx. 232,000

Make a request to the Lord that the city of Laayoune be flooded with Life Water, which fills people's spiritual thirst and leads them to eternal life.

DAY 22

MARCH 11 – WEDNESDAY

Pray for global workers around the world who are about to enter areas that are either completely off-limits or extremely dangerous, and where very few or no other witnesses of the gospel have gone before. Pray that they will have the courage to follow God wherever he leads, that he will protect them, and that spiritual doors will open for them.

DAY 23

MARCH 12 – THURSDAY

Acts 4: 12

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”

Pray that People of Islam will see that Jesus Christ is the only way to be saved.

DAY 24

MARCH 13 - FRIDAY

TRIPOLI, LIBYA

Region: North Africa Population:
Approx. 3.1 million

Pray that Tripoli's people may accept the One who loves and wants to redeem them. Pray to end the civil war, which began in 2011 as various factions vie for power. Pray for peaceful elections, a way out of violence, war, and instability, and leaders with integrity and justice.

DAY 25

MARCH 14 – SATURDAY

Pray that Christians all across the world, who make up the Body of Christ, will respond appropriately to the challenge posed by the Bible in James 2:14-16. Pray specifically for the immigrants and refugees all around the world who are yearning for a safer life and a brighter future. Ask God to place faithful believers in their path who will care for them and demonstrate God's love for them in concrete ways.

DAY 26

MARCH 15 – SUNDAY

Jeremiah 29: 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

Hebrews 11: 6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Pray for People of Islam who want to know what God's truth is but can't get a Bible. Pray that God will let them know who He is.

DAY 27

MARCH 16 - MONDAY

DAMASCUS, SYRIA

Region: The Middle East Population:

Approx. 2.3 million

Pray that God will revitalize war-weary souls with the Good News of Jesus Christ and rebuild the city with the hope of the gospel. Ask God to sweep the city with a wave of Christ-belief, and pray for Syrian believers to fearlessly spread the Gospel.

DAY 28

MARCH 17 - TUESDAY

Laylat-al-Qadr

(‘The Night of Power’ – upon which it is believed the Prophet Mohammed first received the scriptures of the Qur’an)

People of Islam believe paradise is open and sins are forgiven. Some People of Islam stay up late to pray and recite the Quran. Devout People of Islam pray at mosques.

PRAY THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL OVERTAKE MANY AND BRING THEM TO THE TRUTH OF THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST!

DAY 29

MARCH 18 - WEDNESDAY

Luke 14: 26, 27 “If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple.27And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

Pray that Muslim people who are seeking to know about Christ will realize and be willing to pay the price of following Jesus.

DAY 30

MARCH 19 - THURSDAY

FES, MOROCCO

Region: North Africa Population:
Approx. 1.2 million

Pray that the people of Fes will raise their eyes and welcome the King of glory into their hearts, homes, and communities with open arms. Pray for God to develop the city into a hub of Jesus Christ education. Pray the Lord to raise up believers from Muslim backgrounds who will share the gospel with boldness and assurance. Pray that the underground church in Morocco will flourish and proliferate.

DAY 31
MARCH 20 - FRIDAY
**Eid-al-Fitr (The Breaking of
the Fast)**

Lord, just as You revealed Yourself to the centurion in Acts 10, we pray that You reveal Yourself to People of Islam around the world in dreams and visions. We're aware that you've done this for People of Islam in the past, and we know that it is within Your power to soften their hearts and reveal that there is only one way to find righteousness, and that is through the transforming grace of Christ.

Lord, we pray that you are with those who have already experienced glimmers of your salvation. Please be with them. Please, Father, continue to work in their hearts so that they can completely accept your grace and place their hope in you. Thank you. I beseech you, Lord, to watch over them and grant them the fortitude they need to take this important step. We are aware that it is not easy for them to turn away from the religion of their parents and follow You, and that doing so comes at a high price. Give them the ability to make the most important decision of their life – the decision to follow Christ — with the strength, wisdom, peace, and joy that they need.
